

Tickets

Day Return tickets are available from the driver. The current maximum Day Return ticket is £5.00, offering great value for the longer journey.

Travel Surrey offers a range of ticket options on routes 514 / 515 / 515A

Adult and Child tickets are available for travel on every bus at all times. Child fares are available at half the adult fare. Only Children Under 5 can travel free (with a fare paying passenger) on these routes.

Single Tickets – Valid for one single journey at any time on day of travel.

Return Tickets – Valid for one return journey at any time on the same day.

Day Explorer – Valid for Unlimited travel on day of purchase on routes 514 / 515 / 515A and all Travel Surrey services in Surrey (not London Buses Services).

Surrey Concessionary Travel pass holders can travel free on routes 514 / 515 / 515A after 0900 Monday to Friday and all day Saturday and Sunday. London Freedom pass holders can travel free between Kingston Hospital and Seething Wells / Effingham Road.

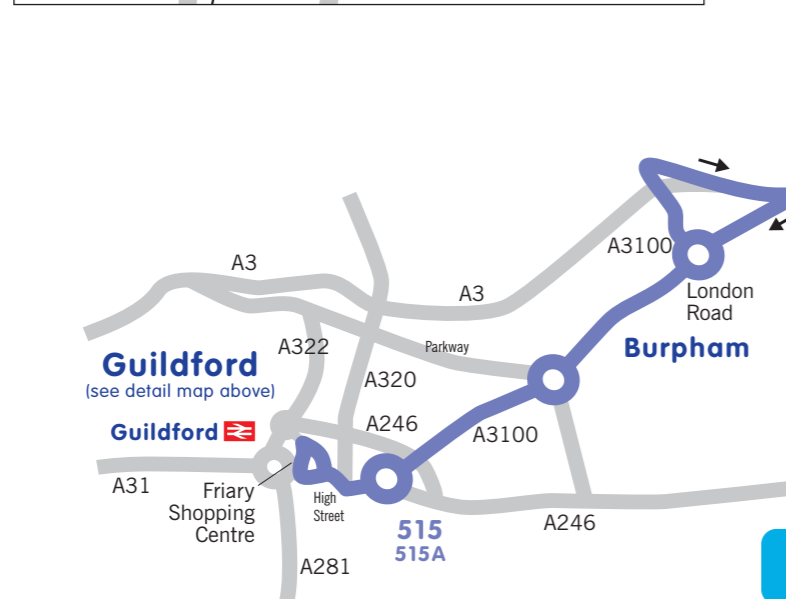
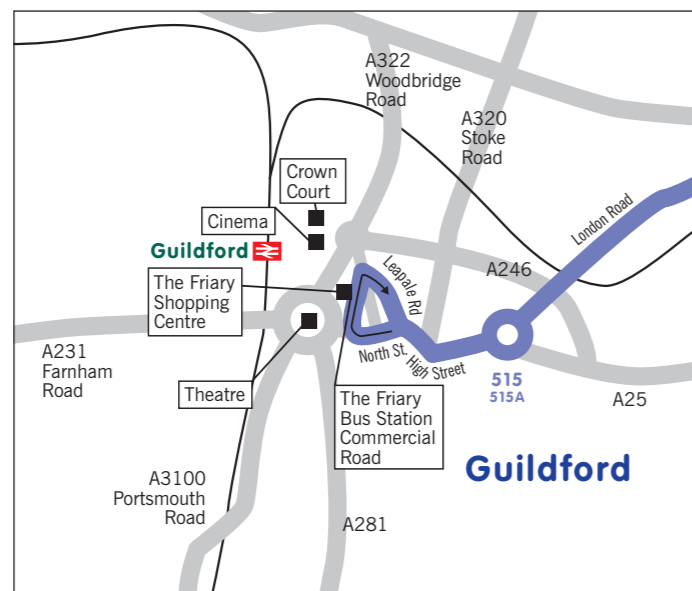

A weekly ticket valid for unlimited travel between any two specific points for 7 days. Prices are based on the Adult Single fare, depending on the length of your journey.

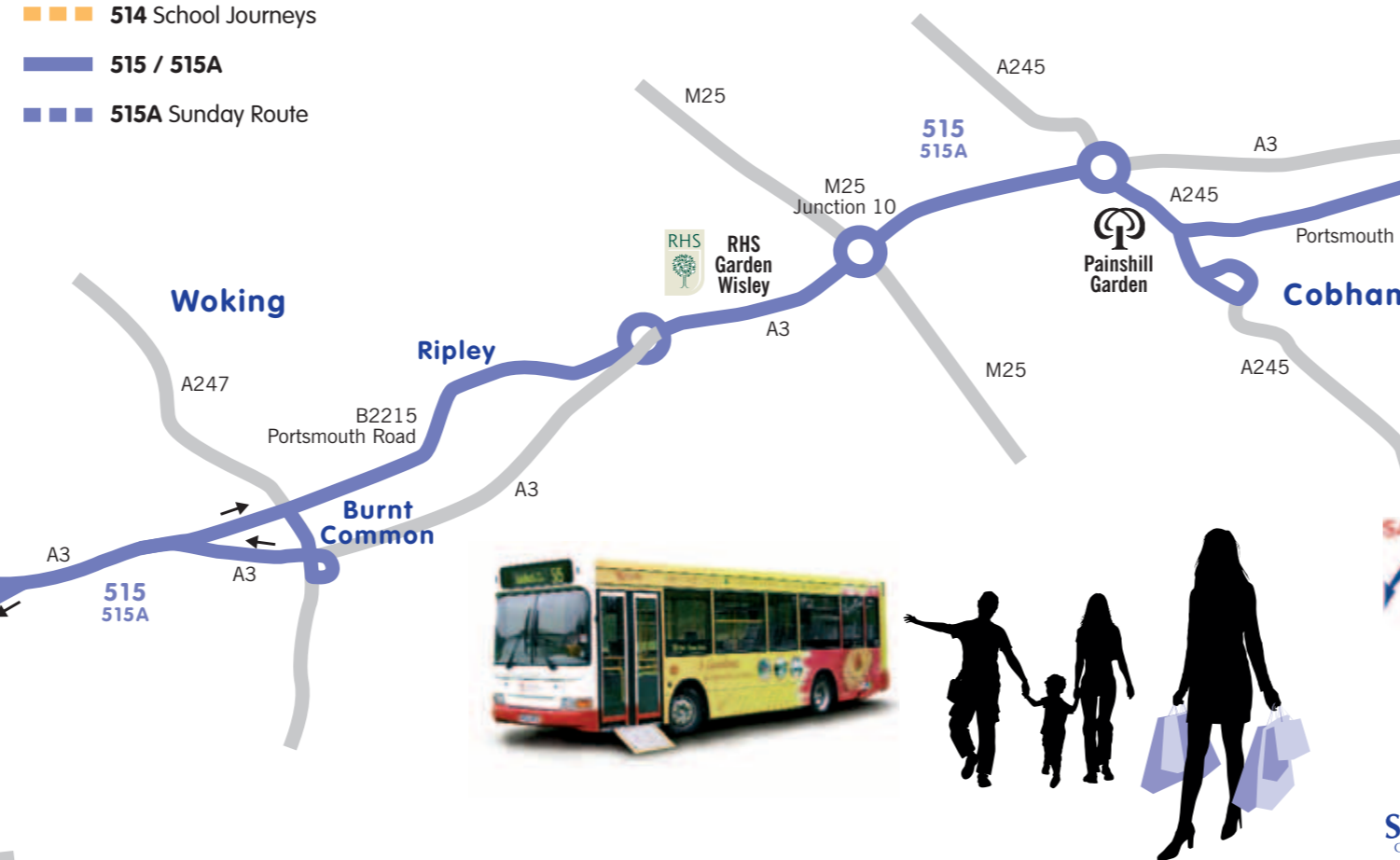
You can buy the FARESAVER ticket from the driver on the bus.

514 / 515 Route Map

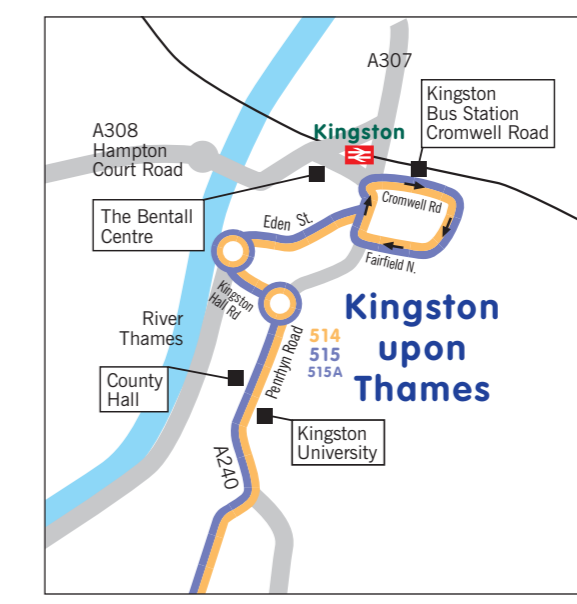
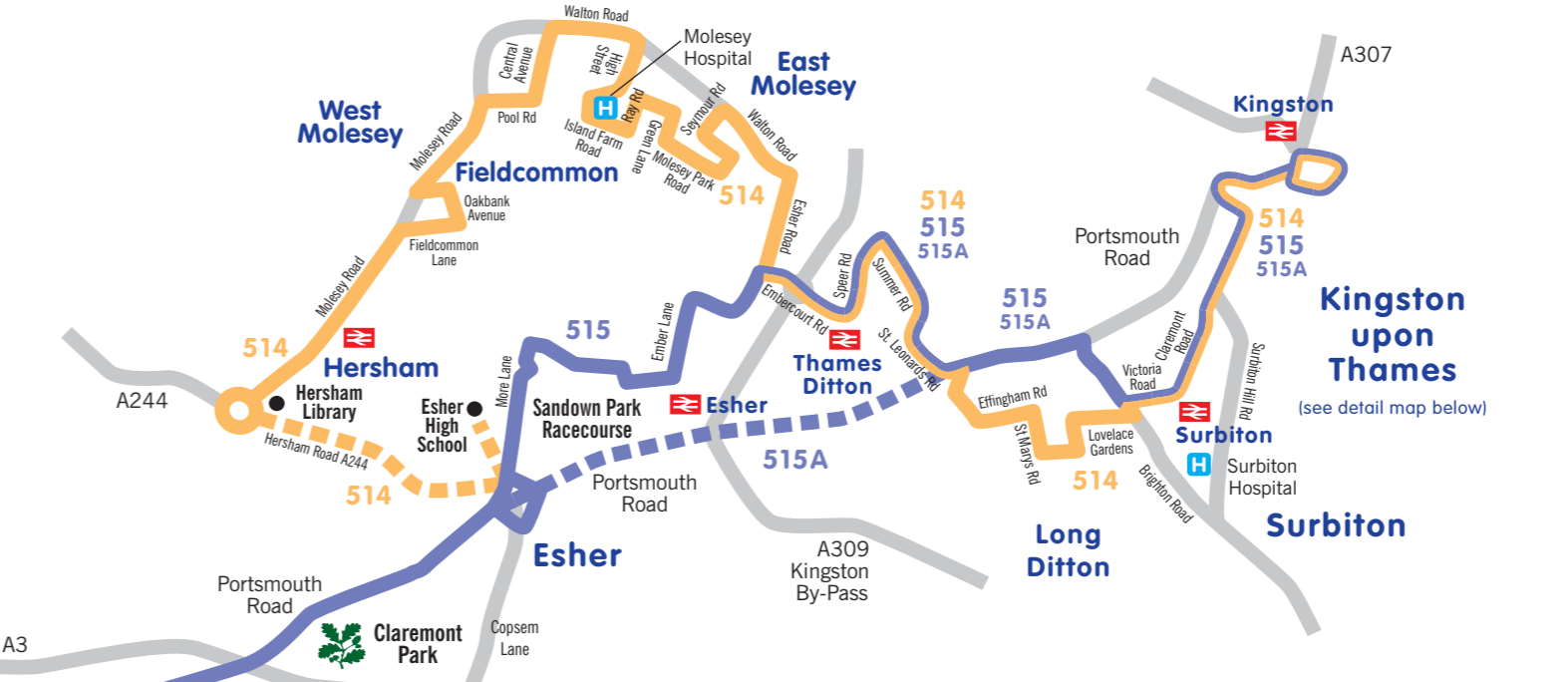
